Camp Details

Children on Campus: SBCV Studentz Camp is for rising 6th graders through recent high school graduates. This is in compliance with our insurance guidelines and Liberty University policy. Please refrain from bringing any children under the established Studentz Camp age.

Check-in: Upon arrival to campus, the youth leader or one adult leader should report to check-in in the DeMoss building 1st floor – room 1105 & 1106. The remaining campers will attend orientation (student & adult) during this time in the same general area. Camp balance is to be paid in full at time of check in. Please bring a check for the payment, no credit cards.

Check out: Please review the schedule for Friday morning check out. Campers are to leave the rooms locked and as they found them upon arrival to camp. An envelope will be provided on each room mirror to place room keys upon check out. Adult leaders, please check that all your students have followed this process before locking the door to their rooms.

Break out Sessions: Churches choosing the Traditional track will participate in Break Out Sessions Tuesday – Thursday. Your entire group will go to sessions together. You will receive Break Out Session assignments upon check-in at camp.

Adult Leaders: We need all adult leaders/chaperones to be active and assist in a variety of ways. Adult leaders are responsible for their students at all times. We ask that you encourage student participation during rec as well as model participation and assist rec leaders as needed. We also need your assistance with decision counseling during Family Group time, Worship time and throughout camp as needed.

Church Group Time: Time has been allotted in the schedule for churches to meet each day following evening worship. This is a time for you to reflect on the daily activities, worship time, Bible study and follow up on any decisions that have been made. Your church group will be assigned a room to meet. Curriculum will be provided for you to use during Monday evening's church group time only. See included material.

Camp Covenant: Camp and conduct rules must be followed. Each camper should have signed and returned this form agreeing to follow all camp rules and policies. Adult leaders, please enforce with your students. (see attached copy)

Lanyard Name Badges: Badges will be provided in the church packet at check-in for each camper. The badge will contain the camper's name, church, youth pastor, rec team color, family group number, and camp schedule. Name badges must be worn *around the neck* at all times and are required to enter camp activities.

Meal Card: We are required to use Liberty University meal cards during all meal times. These cards will be provided and should be worn on the lanyard around your neck along with your name badge. There is a fee of \$5 to replace lost cards. You must have your *individual* meal card to enter the cafeteria – no sharing.

Lost Keys/Damages: Lost keys will be replaced at the student's expense. All damages made by students to the campus or dorm rooms will be charged to the church group.

Family Group Bible Study: Campers will be divided into age appropriate groups of approximately 15 co-ed students and adult leaders from your church and other churches. Camp Staffers will facilitate the group Bible studies and devotion time. Recreation and Family Group Bible Study will be on a rotation. Campers will either have Rec followed by Family Groups or Family Groups followed by Rec. The camp booklet will list your Rec color rotation time.

Organized Recreation: ALL campers will participate in morning organized recreation activities. Campers are divided by Rec Color for this activity time (RED, BLUE, GREEN, etc). Recreation and Family Group Bible Study will be on a rotation. Campers will either have Rec followed by Family Groups or Family Groups followed by Rec. The camp booklet will list your Rec color rotation time.

Free Time: The LaHaye Student Center offers ping-pong, pool tables, basketball, swimming pool and more. Churches will receive wrist bands for campers to wear during camp to admit you to use these facilities at no extra cost. *Churches are responsible for their students during free time.*

Snack Time: Concessions will be open in the Vines center Tues-Thurs evening during and just after the concert. (drinks \$2; chips/candy \$1; etc.) Churches will also have the option to order pizzas for their groups each day. Please place your order in the Camp Office before lunch or at the adult leader meeting at 1:30 in the cafeteria. Cost per pizza is \$10 each (large one topping). *Orders for Monday night must be placed during Check-In.*

Charter buses: Those churches that must charter buses to bring your group to camp, please take notice of the schedule for Friday morning. Check-out must be complete by 9:00 a.m. Please make arrangements for the bus to arrive at the appropriate time to pick up your luggage or you may leave your group's luggage in a designated area in the Vines Center.

Ice Skating: NEW! We have organized an Ice Skating optional activity for each church. Churches choosing the Traditional track will be assigned one day to utilize these facilities during free time 3:30-5:00 p.m. Churches choosing the Missions Track will have the opportunity to utilize these facilities during a special Late Night Skate for Missions Track only on Thursday night following Church Group Time, 10:30p.m.-12:00a.m. *Churches are responsible for their students during this activity. There is NO additional cost to use this facility on the day and time you are assigned.*

Who does my mom/dad contact in case of emergency?

- Each church group is responsible for having a line of communication with parents/home church (a.k.a. adult leader's cell phone). The contact person at camp should be the youth pastor/director. Each youth director is encouraged to contact his/her home church daily. Adult chaperones may bring cell phones as well. Camp staff will work with youth directors in the event of an emergency.
- SBCV Studentz Camp will also have a camp office set up on campus for medical/emergency needs. Students may pick up mail at the camp office.
- Students are not permitted to leave camp early, unless sent home due to disciplinary issues. Parents are welcome to visit camp, but are *not* encouraged to do so, since parental visits often lead to homesickness issues.

Northbound on 29 (From Danville): From 29 N, take exit for 460 East. Take exit for Candler's Mtn. Rd./Liberty University. At stop sign, make a right. Go to the first light, and make a left onto the University Blvd. Stay straight through light, and enter Liberty's campus.

Southbound on 29 (From Charlottesville): From 29 S, take exit onto 460 W towards Lynchburg. Take the Candler's Mtn. Rd./University Blvd. exit. At the light, make a left, and enter Liberty's campus.

Eastbound on 460: Take the Candler's Mtn. Road (Rte 670) exit. At the stop sign, make a right. Go to the first light, and make a left onto University Blvd. Stay straight through the light, and enter Liberty's campus.

Westbound on 460 or Northbound on 501: Take the Candler's Mtn. Rd./University Blvd. exit. At the light, make a left, and enter Liberty's campus.

Camp Covenant

Do's

- » Wear name tags & meal cards at all times. These should be placed on the lanyard provided and worn around your neck only. Your nametag is your entry to camp activities and you need your meal card for all meals. There is a fee of \$5 to replace lost meal cards, no sharing cards.
- » Participate in all activities as they are required and please be on time (including recreation).
- » Be respectful to everyone
- » Submit to the instruction and direction of SBCV Studentz Camp staff, adult leaders, and youth pastors.
- » Obey scheduled times for room checks and curfew without exception; quiet hours will be enforced.
- » Please bring a change of clothes to wear to evening worship (no shorts). Ex. jeans and t-shirt

Don'ts

- » Damage property—you break it you pay for it.
- » PDA (public displays of affection)--this week is about you and God, not your boyfriend or girlfriend!
- » If you don't personally own it...don't touch it
- » Enter into dorms of the opposite gender at any time (adults included)
- » Order food off-campus – (churches may place pizza orders with the Camp Office – see Snack Time under Camp Details)
- » Leave campus at **any** time, even with your youth pastor/director/leader. (Camp Office must be notified if anyone needs to leave camp for **any** reason)

What to Bring

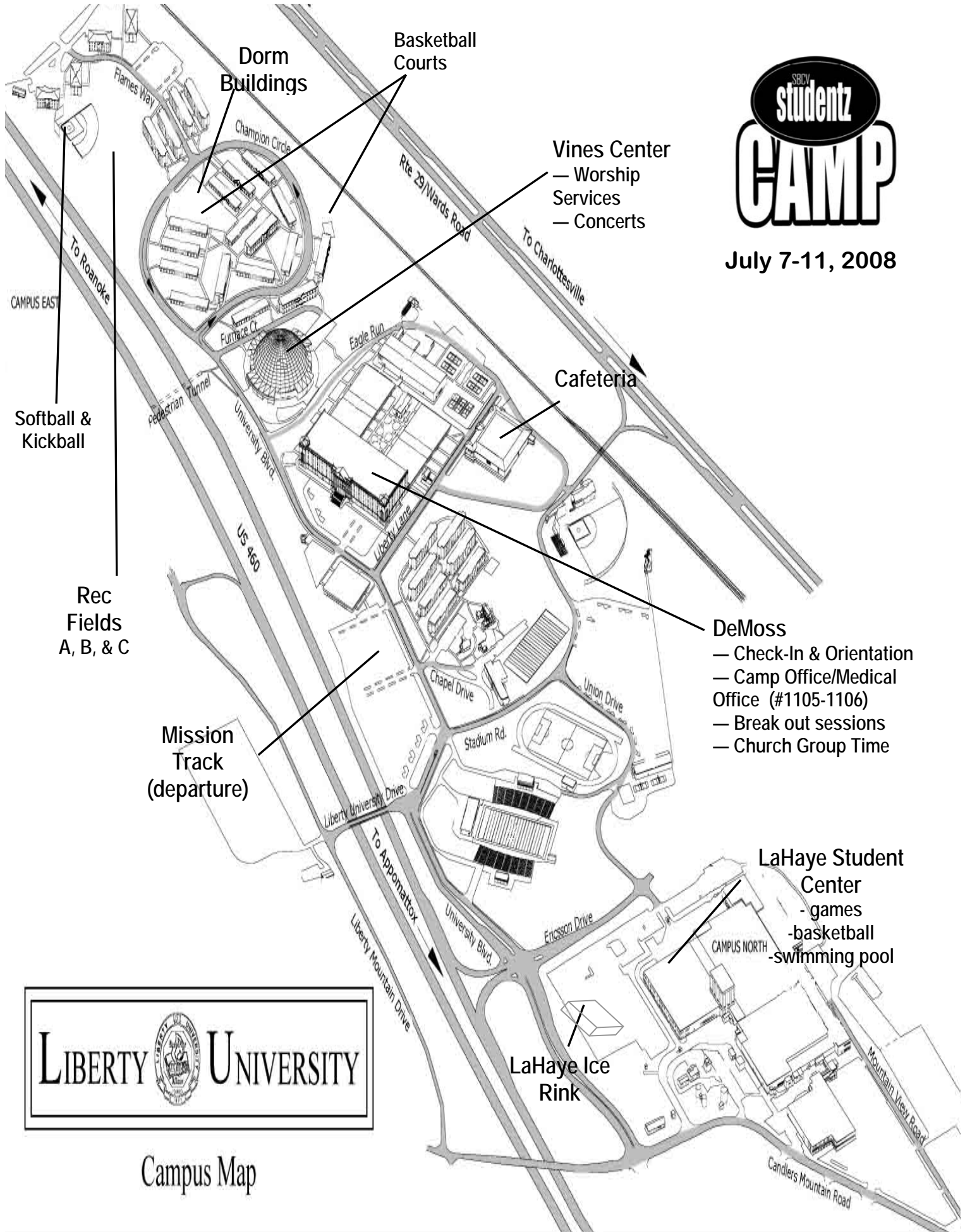
- » Bible and a Pen to take notes on what God is saying to you
- » Swimsuit/towel (no speedos or bikinis...no exceptions)
- » Several changes of clothes (casual clothes for recreation or missions and change of clothes for evening worship services)
- » Change of clothes to wear to evening worship, ex. jeans, but no shorts (casual clothing, dress clothes not needed)
- » Sunscreen and insect repellent
- » Sheets or sleeping bag and pillow
- » Modest Clothing (shorts must be fingertip length; skirts no shorter than 2 inches above the knee) You will be asked to change!
- » Extra \$\$\$\$ for some CDs, t-shirts, books, snacks
- » Towels, flip-flops for the shower, wash cloths/toiletries
- » A LOUD alarm clock so that you can be on time to breakfast
- » Disposable camera to capture those priceless moments at camp
- » A phone card to call Mom so she doesn't get lonely (no cell phones allowed except for adult leaders)

What Not to Bring

- » Weapons of any kind – example: knives, firearms, hand grenades, etc.
- » Leave the short shorts at home - fingertip length only
- » T-shirts with alcohol or tobacco ads
- » Girls: No strapless or spaghetti strap shirts (3 fingers wide—your fingers), no bikini swim suits
- » Guys: No Speedos (girls don't like them anyway)
- » Shaving cream (use electric or soap and water)
- » Drugs, alcohol, or tobacco of any kind
- » Cell phones (except for Adult Leaders)
- » Radios, TVs, CD players, MP3 players, video games
- » Skateboards, rollerblades, go-karts, or portable helicopters
- » Valuable items/jewelry that can get broken or lost are discouraged; SBCV Studentz Camp is not responsible.
